(A). Owner of each animal exhibited must be a member of the Irish Angus Cattle Society for a minimum period of 3 months preceeding the Irish Angus Cattle Society All Ireland finals at Strokestown show on September 10<sup>th</sup> 2011 and each animal entered must also have been registered in the owners name in the herd book of the Irish Angus Cattle Society for a minimum period of 3 months preceeding the Irish Angus Cattle Society All Ireland finals at Strokestown Show.

For each individual qualifying show owner of each animal exhibited must be a member of the Irish Angus Cattle Society and each animal entered must also have been registered in the owners name in the herd book of the Irish Angus Cattle Society.

(B) Date of birth & Tag number/Herd Book number must be clearly shown for each entry and this information shall be displayed in the Show catalogue

(C) All exhibitors must have their Irish Angus Cattle Society Herd Book certificate available for production to the Irish Angus Cattle Society's representative in accordance with the requirements of clause A above.

All pedigree Angus Cattle born before 1/9/10 and satisfying the above pre-conditions are eligible. One or more qualifiers to go forward to the All Ireland Irish Angus Senior Championship final on September 10th 2011 at Strokestown Show.

**Rules and Conditions**

1. The competition is open to all breeds of non pedigree heifers suitable to produce and rear a calf with potential for current commercial beef markets.
2. Heifers may be in calf or maiden at final. For heifers that are in-calf, evidence must be produced, i.e. scanning cert or insemination cert..
3. Heifer's potential mothering ability will be assessed.
4. **Up to two heifers** may qualify at each show if the standard is deemed sufficient.
5. Individual exhibitors may qualify up to two heifers for the final.
6. All heifers **must** be halter trained and led by a competent adult.
7. Animals qualifying for this final are **ineligible** for entry to other classes at the Swinford Show other than qualifying classes for other finals.
8. **The foregoing rules should be read in conjunction with ISA General Rules for 2011 together with Swinford Show rules.**
